White Wines

- 100 PINOT GRIGIO, LA CASADA, ITALY - **£10.00 or £2.05 (glass)**
Great Pinot Grigio-fresh and crisp with an appley melon twist. Everything you would expect in a Pinot Grigio and a lot more!
- 101 SAUVIGNON BLANC, LAS CONDES, CHILE- **£10.50 or £2.25 (glass)**
Intensely floral with elderflower notes and a grassy quality. The palate reflects the same fruit profile with crisp acidity and a touch of citrus fruit on the finish. This is a dry, crisp and refreshing wine.
- 102 SEMILLON/CHARDONNAY, JACOBITE RIDGE, AUSTRALIA - **£11.50**
A rich, buttery and smooth classic Aussie Chardonnay with added complexity—very subtle and balanced.
- 103 VERDEJO/SAUVIGNON BLANC, PUCELA HIJOS DE ALBERTO, SPAIN - **£12.25**
Pale yellow colour, fruity and intense bouquet with touches of white fruit. The palate is dry and fruity with a refreshing edge of acidity.
- 104 VIOGNIER ORGANIC, YALUMBA, AUSTRALIA - **£13.50**
This wine shows musk, stone fruit and citrus aromas and flavours across textured layers
- 105 CHENIN BLANC, MULDERBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA - **£14.00**
A clean, lively wine with nuances of nutmeg and cloves. Well balanced, dry and elegant, but with weight and a powerful follow-through on the palate.
- 106 CHARDONNAY 'CITRINE', GEMTREE, AUSTRALIA- **£14.75**
A wonderful example of how to balance the use of oak with the quality of fruit, this will banish all unpleasant memories of over-oaked Aussie Chardonnays for good!
- 107 MACON BLANC, JOSEPH DROUHIN, FRANCE - **£15.30**
Pale straw golden colour, exhibiting classic white Burgundy aromas, butter and bread, with rich Chardonnay fruit on the palate.
- 108 GAVI LA ZERBA, PIEDMONTE, ITALY - **£15.95**
A lovely pure wine with a perfumed nose of honeysuckle and pear. This reflects onto the palate and is balanced by some tropical fruit and lovely mineral fresh acidity.
- 109 CHABLIS, DOMAINE DU COLOMBIER, FRANCE - **£17.20**
A perfect example of what can be done in the region. It is a pure and authentic wine vinified and aged in stainless steel tanks to retain all its freshness and mineral character.
- 110 SAUVIGNON BLANC, CLOUDY BAY, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND—**£22.00**
Layers of pure, bracing fruit flavours on the palate finish with terrific intensity and length and the crispness of a crunchy green apple.

Bubbles

- 400 CAVA CASTELL LLORD BRUT NV NATURE, SPAIN - **£12.30**
This is a clean, fresh and dry bubbly that is sophisticated enough for just about any meal.
- 401 PROSECCO PRIMA PERLA, ITALY - **£13.80 or £2.95 (glass)**
This wonderful Prosecco is perfect for any special occasion and while this would make a lovely aperitif, it has enough character to accompany most pastas as well as shellfish.
- 402 CHAMPAGNE M MAILLART BRUT NV, FRANCE- **£23.80**
A remarkable Champagne— 75% Chardonnay from Nicolas Maillart's own vineyards. Delicate dry with light biscuit flavours and finesse.

Red Wines

- 200 PRIMITIVO, LA CASADA, ITALY - **£10.00 or £2.05 (glass)**
Rich, fulsome, plummy fruit & spice aromas lead to a juicy wine of rich tannins, great length and delicious concentrated flavour. Very quaffable!
- 201 MERLOT, LAS CONDES, CHILE - **£10.50 or £2.25 (glass)**
Smooth and easy, on the palate these develop to show plum and prune flavours with an accessible structure.
- 202 SHIRAZ/CABERNET, JACOBITE RIDGE, AUSTRALIA- **£11.50**
Sweet cherry and liquorice flavours and a gorgeous velvety texture. A real charmer.
- 203 MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO, ITALY - **£12.00**
Intense ruby red in colour with violet reflections; lovely ripe aromas of red fruits and cherries. On the palate this is full and smooth.
- 204 MALBEC, DON CRISTOBAL, AARENTINA - **£12.50**
Fine and elegant aroma with a perfect combination of ripe red fruits and spices, enriched by the use of French oak. In the mouth it is balanced with soft tannins.
- 205 COTES DU VENTOUX, PARCELLES 38, VIGNOBLES QUIOT, FRANCE - **£13.50**
Grenache and Syrah grapes giving a medium bodied red with masses of ripe black fruit on the nose. Juicy and delicious.
- 206 SHIRAZ, CERAVOLO, AUSTRALIA - **£14.75**
Well balanced and rich giving excellent structure with a good depth of flavour. Wonderful with red meats, pasta dishes and cheese.
- 207 PINOTAGE, SPRINGFONTEIN, SOUTH AFRICA - **£15.50**
The wine is spicy, with a good balance of wood on the nose and palate. The tannins are soft and velvety, a classic wine from South Africa.
- 208 RIOJA RESERVA, CAMPILLO, SPAIN - **£17.80**
Ripe cherry and red berry aromas, smoky, spicy and intense
- 209 ZINFANDEL, KNOTTY VINES, RODNEY STRONG, USA **£19.50**
Fresh, bright berry fruit combined with the ripe peppery jamminess to make a wonderful diversity of flavour showcasing the best that Zinfandel can offer.
- 210 CHATEAU PUYUERAUND 202, ST EMILION, FRANCE - **£22.00**
Dark, ruby colour, powerful aroma of wild blackcurrants backed by an incredible soft palate-inky and rich—excellent claret. Owned by the makers of Chateau Le Pin.

Rose Wines

- 300 SYRAH, CUVÉE VALONNÉE, FRANCE - **£10.50 or £2.25 (glass)**
An easy drinking light rose, a perfect partner to salads and lighter dishes, but also a very pleasant aperitif.
- 301 ROSE SOUL, SANTA EMA, CHILE—**£11.50**
A blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Syrah. The wine is dry, fresh and elegant with an intense aroma of strawberry & raspberry.
